History From the Lodge

**Paul Revere**

**Grand Master Of Masons In Massachusetts  
1795-1797**

He was an early initiate of St. Andrew's Lodge in 1760, the first "ancient" lodge in Boston. and spent forty of his eighty-three years as an active Mason. He was involved in creating the Massachusetts Grand Lodge of Ancient Masons, through which he participated in the organization and spread of masonry throughout the state. By the time he was Grand Master in 1794 the Grand Lodge of Massachusetts was chartering Lodges in Massachusetts, Maine, Vermont, Connecticut and New Hampshire. Revere himself added twenty three during his three year term. Paul Revere also played an integral part in writing the final resolution which declared the independence of the Grand Lodge from Great Britain, in keeping with his desire for an independent America.

He saw Massachusetts Freemasonry through the hazardous transition from colony to state, and experienced the brunt of the turmoil through St. Andrew's Lodge when it chose to remain loyal to the Grand Lodge of Scotland. He created Rising States Lodge which eventually failed, and perhaps disillusioned him, but he offered the craft his loyalty, and constantly worked through offices and committees to preserve and perpetuate its integrity. His was the glorious age of Masonry, prior to the Morgan Affair and the anti-masonic crusade of the 1820's when the Fraternity grew unhindered and flourished in public processions and ceremonies, laid cornerstones and attracted men of influence in every community.

**From the Worshipful Master's Desk**

Grand Lodge Per Capita went up by \$6.00, effective August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014. During our last Stated Meeting we voted to increase our Lodge dues from \$66.00 to **\$90.00**. This will be in addition to Grand Lodge Per Capita fees. **Grand Lodge per capita** fees are currently **\$20.00**, making the total annual dues amount \$90.00 (Blue Lodge) plus \$20.00 (Grand Lodge) or **\$110.00** total amount due..

We will be taking the final vote of approval at our next Stated Meeting on September 8<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 PM. **We must have a 75% approval for this increase to pass.** We welcome all members input and urge you to attend & voice your opinions AND Vote.

From the Secretary Corner of the Lodge-Room

August 2014

My Brothers, in the past your “**Renewal Dues Notice**” had information as: Dues For: **2014**; Amount of Dues: **\$80.00** (since 2013); Voluntary contribution MH-100: **\$7.30** (two cent per day since 2010); Total Amount: **\$87.30**.

At the last Grand Lodge Communication, the Craft approved to increase the “**Per-Capita**” by **\$6.00** and with the current “**Per-Capita**” of **\$14.00** that will make it **\$20.00** for year 2015. How do we collect this amount in the past was by your Lodge sending to the Grand Lodge the amount owed by its members the Grand Lodge calculated. The **\$14.00 “Per-Capita”** we sent to Grand Lodge came out of the **\$80.00** we received from your Dues payment. This left us only with **\$66.00** for Lodge expenses.

The wording in our by-laws has changed in accordance with our “dues” paragraph. It will be written \$\_\_\_\_\_ (Dues Amount) plus Grand Lodge per capita. We will fill in the amount of our Lodge dues and the per capita will be automatically be added to that amount. That way, whenever the Grand Lodge increases it’s per capita, the particular lodges do not have to vote for an increase and re-write their by-laws.

The Dues notice you will receive in October will be: Dues For: **2015**; Amount of Dues: **\$110.00** (combination of **\$90.00** plus the current **\$14.00** and the increase of **\$6.00 Per-Capita =\$20.00**); Voluntary contribution MH-100: **\$7.30**; Total Amount: **\$117.30**.

The figures to remember are **\$110.00** and **\$117.30**.

Think “**Perpetual Membership**” and eliminate any confusion to any increases in “**Dues**” or “**Per-Capita**” that has no bearing on “**Perpetual Membership**” or “**50**” year Members.

We are anticipating another Per Capita Increase in 2016. If you have any questions, call or visit the Lodge.
