From the EAST

The Cable Toe

A Cable Tow is a line or rope for drawing or leading. The word is purely Masonic and in some writings in the early part of the eighteenth century we find the expression "cable rope". The German word for cable or rope is "kabeltau" and it is most likely the source of the English "cable tow".

In its first inception, the Cable Tow seems only to have been used as a physical means of controlling the candidate, and such interpretation is still in the EA degree. In the second and third degrees a more modern symbolism has been introduced, and the Cable Tow is, in these grades, supposed to symbolize the covenant by which all Masons are tied.

According to the ancient laws of Freemasonry, every brother must attend his Lodge if he is within the length of his Cable Tow. The old writers define the length of a Cable Tow, which they sometimes called "cables length", to be three miles for an Entered Apprentice. But the expression is really symbolic and means the scope of a man's reasonable ability.

William W. Vickers wrote in June 1898 in the Canadian Craftsman that "The Cable Tow is thus a symbol of the cord of the bond of Love, which should unite the whole fraternity. Its length, or the length of your Cable Tow, is the sacrifice you are willing to make on behalf of your brethren. It is in your heart, not to be measured by miles. It is not gauged by distances, but by deed. It should correspond to the immensity of the monitorial lodge, and to do so should span the earth, touching wherever there is sorrow or distress".
