Proxy Needed:

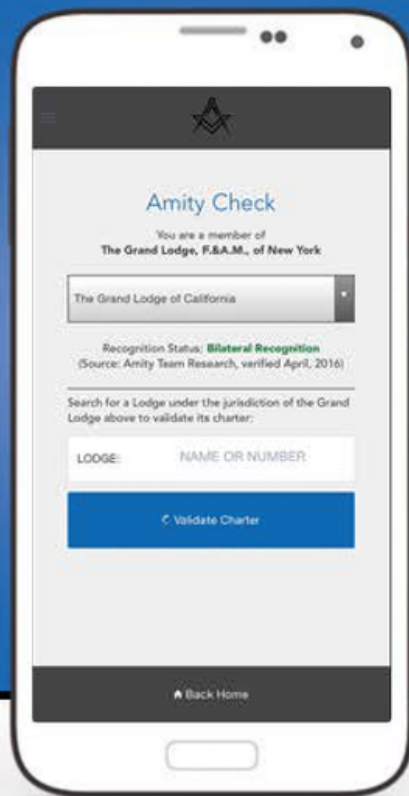
