To: All Particular Lodges



Atala, Grand Master, do hereby order and direct, that effective until March 31, 2026, any Particular Lodge in our Grand Jurisdiction that desires to reinstate a suspended Brother without payment of past dues, may do so by adopting the attached Resolution, which adopted Resolution **must be returned to the Grand Secretary's Office over the Seal of the Lodge, in order to be effective.** And, if adopted, I hereby waive the provisions of Regulations 27.09 and Regulation 27.14 concerning the payment of past Per Capita Tax including the Per Capita Tax for 2025 due to the Grand Lodge. These Brothers may be reinstated according to the provisions of Regulation 27.13 of the Digest of Masonic Law and the payment of current year's dues.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

7.02 Manner and Method of Election. – In the election of Officers, nominations shall be made in writing to the Lodge Secretary no later than the opening of the first Stated Communication in November and no other nominations will be accepted thereafter. The nominee shall also make a statement in writing stating that he will accept the position if elected no later than the opening of the first Stated Communication in November and no other acceptance letters will be accepted thereafter. Discussions regarding nominees for office may take place among Brethren, but not in open Lodge. A majority of all votes cast, respectively, shall determine. In each succeeding ballot for the same office, when more than two members are voted for, the name or names of the Brother or Brethren having the lowest number of votes, shall, by order of the Master, be dropped; and all votes cast in derogation of said order shall not be counted. (2017)

Time of Elections shall be held in accordance to By-Law Section 7.01 of Regulation 24.05 of the Digest of the Masonic Law of Florida, Uniform Code of By-Laws. (2017)

It is with deep sadness that we share the passing of our Brother, Addison Leroy Bain, who departed this life on January 22, 2025, in Melbourne, Florida, at the age of 89.

Brother Bain lived a remarkable life of service, science, and faith. Born on September 23, 1935, in Kalispell, Montana, he went on to dedicate his career to engineering and aerospace, serving with NASA and contributing to historic space programs including Mercury, Gemini, Apollo, and the Space Shuttle. His groundbreaking research into the Hindenburg disaster reshaped our understanding of history and shed light on the truth.

A devoted family man, Brother Bain is survived by his daughter Debra Lindsay, grandson Justin, granddaughter Tiffany, his brothers Stanley and Daryl, and many nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends. He also leaves behind a legacy of knowledge, innovation, and brotherhood that will continue to inspire us all.

As Masons, we are reminded that though the working tools of life are laid down, the influence of a well-lived life continues to guide us. Brother Bain's work and passion for discovery reached beyond the stars, and his light will forever shine in our hearts bit of body text

For over four decades, Brother Bruce was a pillar of our Masonic community. He was initiated on November 30, 1979, passed on March 3, 1980, and raised on April 14, 1980. His commitment was recognized with a well-deserved 40-year service award on April 14, 2020. Throughout his journey, he held many important roles, including serving as Marshall and Senior Deacon in 2002 and Senior Warden in 2003. His leadership shone brightly as the Worshipful Master of Brevard 113 in 2007, where he was a plural member. He also dedicated his time and skills to the Public Relations Chair and the Public Education & Citizenship Committee in 2007, and later to LYPMGC and MH-100 in 2015. Brother Bruce was a true master of his craft, also holding his Blue Proficiency Card.

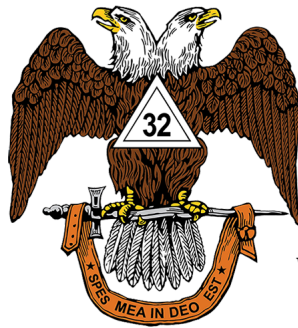

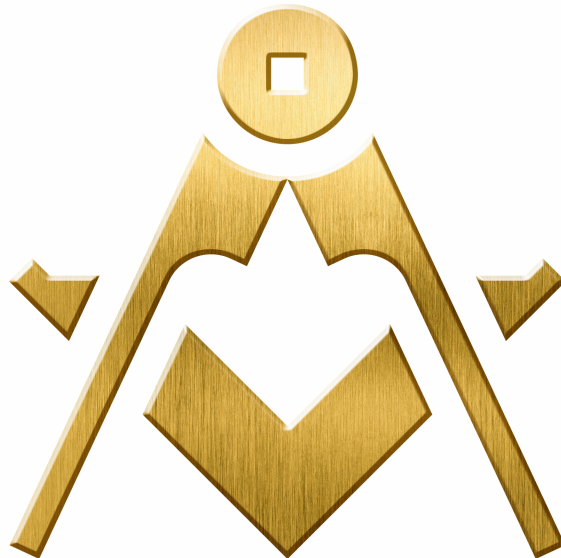
