

In Memoriam Worshipful Brother Rodney Paul Bornefeld, PM November 12, 1946 – November 22, 2025

It is with profound sorrow that we report the passing of Worshipful Brother Rodney Paul Bornefeld, Past Master of Canaveral Lodge No. 339, who laid down his working tools on November 22, 2025.

W\ Bro\ Bornefeld began his journey in Freemasonry when he was Initiated on April 17, 1978, Passed on September 28, 1978, and Raised to the Sublime Degree of Master Mason on March 24, 1979. For more than 46 years, he remained a faithful and devoted Brother, upholding the principles of Freemasonry with dignity, humility, and unwavering dedication.

Throughout his extensive Masonic career, he served Canaveral Lodge with distinction, holding several important offices, including Senior Deacon, Junior Warden, Senior Warden, and ultimately Worshipful Master. His leadership was steady and thoughtful, and his influence helped guide the Lodge through many seasons of growth and transition.

In addition to his service within our Lodge, W\ Bro\ Bornefeld also contributed to the Craft, serving as a District Chairman of the Child ID Committee. His work in this vital program reflected his deep commitment to the safety and well-being of the children in our communities.

His long-standing devotion was recognized through his 25-Year and 40-Year Service Awards, a testament to a life spent in quiet labor for the benefit of his Brothers and the betterment of the Fraternity.

W\ Bro\ Bornefeld will be remembered for his humility, his integrity, and his genuine kindness. He lived the teachings of Masonry every day, not for titles or accolades, but from a true desire to serve.

As we reflect on his life and legacy, we take comfort in knowing that he has been called to the Eternal Lodge above, where peace, harmony, and Light are everlasting. Though his earthly labor has concluded, the imprint he leaves upon our Lodge and our hearts will endure.

May the Great Architect of the Universe grant him eternal rest, and may his memory continue to inspire all who follow in his footsteps.


